

Car parking concessions – visitors

Visiting patients on specialty wards

The weekly concession* is immediately available, upon completion of an Approval Form~, as soon as patients are admitted to these areas:

- Acute Neurology and Stroke Gate 2
- Regional Spinal Injuries Centre/Unit Gate 4
- Neonatal Unit Gate 19
- Oncology and Haematology Inpatients Gate 20b / 21
- Regional Burns Unit Gate 29
- Intensive Care Unit / Critical Care Gate 30
- Coronary Care Gate 31b
- High Dependency Unit Gate 34a
- Acute Respiratory Care Units Gate 20a / 27 / 45

Visiting patients who are staying in hospital for a long time

Visitors pay the normal daily rates* for the first seven days. After this visitors can get, upon completion of an Approval Form~, a permit to pay the weekly concession* rate. This applies in these areas:

- Diabetes and Endocrinology Gate 32

Visiting patients who are on end of life care

The daily and weekly concessions* are immediately available, upon completion of an Approval Form~, as soon as patients are admitted.

Visiting Paediatrics and Paediatric Burns

The daily and weekly concessions* are immediately available to parents/direct carers, upon completion of an Approval Form~, as soon as patients are admitted.

Visiting the Maternity and Labour Wards

Permits will be issued for 24 Hours, upon completion of an Approval Form~, at the full daily rate*. This will allow partners to come and go multiple times within the given 24 time period.

Please note: No concessions are available for visitors for general outpatient appointments or visiting the Emergency Department, Ambulatory Care or the Day Surgery Unit

Car parking concessions – Outpatients

Daily and weekly concessions* are available to patients, upon completion of an Approval Form~, attending:

- Regional Spinal Injuries Centre/Unit Gate 4
- Haematology / Breast / Gynaecology Gate 22
- Chemotherapy Gate 23
- Infusion Day Unit

Patients may be eligible to claim back parking fees and mileage if they are in receipt of a Qualifying Benefit, and produce receipts for parking charges. Qualifying Benefits include:

- Income Based Employment Support Allowance (ESA)
- Job Seekers Allowance (JSA)
- Pension Credit Guarantee Credit
- Universal Credit
- HC2 Certificate
- HC3 Certificate (limited help)
- Tax Credit Exemption
- Income Support (IS)
